**NOTIFICATION**

Sub:- CH&FW.,TS., Hyderabad – Issue of Notification for admission into Multi Purpose Health Workers (Female) / ANM Training Course in 1<sup>st</sup> year for the academic year 2021- 2022 (02 years course i.e, 2021-2023) in respect of Private MPHWS (F) Training Institutions – Reg.

The attention of the District Medical and Health Officers in the state i.e., Member-Convener of the Selection Committee for Multi Purpose Health Workers (Female) / ANM Training Course in the State are invited to the reference 1<sup>st</sup> cited, the Government have issued instructions, that the MPHWS(F) Training Course admissions should be Online.

Accordingly, the **Online** admission application for MPHWS(F) / ANM Training course in 1<sup>st</sup> year for the academic year 2021-2022 is available in the CH&FW official website <http://chfw.telangana.gov.in>. Hence, the following instructions have to be followed while making the admissions for Free (Convener) / Management quota seats in the Government and Private MPHWS (F) Training Institutions available in their respective districts **as per the liability (only recognized schools registered as on date by Indian Nursing Council / TS Nurses Midwives Auxiliary Nurse-Midwives & Health Visitors Council)**

Vide reference 2<sup>nd</sup> cited, the Secretary Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi, passed the resolution as follows,

**Closure of the Nursing Educational Programme:-** If, no admission are made for two consecutive academic years then it shall be considered as closed. If the Institution wants to restart the programme they have to submit the first inspection fees within 5 years i.e, from the year they did not have admissions. Guidelines of the year wherein institute was first permitted will be applicable.

**PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION IN TO MPHWS (F) TRAINING INSTITUTIONS**  
**EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS:**

The Minimum Educational qualification for admission into the Multipurpose Health workers (Female) Training Course shall be Intermediate pass with any group.

**AGE:**

The candidates should have completed the age of 17 years as on 31<sup>st</sup> December of the year in which the admission sought and the upper age limit is 30 years of age. The upper age limit is relaxable by 5 years in case of SC, ST and BC's as per rules in force.

**CATEGORISATION OF SEATS:** 60% of the total number of seats shall be called "Free Seats" and the remaining 40% shall be called "Management Seats"

**METHOD OF ADMISSION:** (1) Admission to "Free seats" shall be made by a selection committee consisting of the following:

The above committee shall make selections purely based on the merit, on the basis of aggregate marks obtained by the candidates in the minimum qualifying examination for Multipurpose Health Workers (Female) Training Course i.e., Intermediate Public Examination or its equivalent with any group. In declaring such merit, candidates who pass under compartmental system shall be placed after candidates who passed in a single attempt and other guidelines for finalizing the merit will be followed.

(2) The Principals of Private MPHWF Training Institutions shall admit candidates as allotted by the above committee on the basis of ranking assigned to them against 60% "Free seats"

(3) The maximum number of students to be admitted in an institution shall not exceed (40) forty. However, if infrastructural facilities, teaching staff etc., in an institution are found to be inadequate to train (40) forty students, Government have the right to permit a lesser number of students.

(4) Admission to "Management Seats" shall be done by the institution only after the list of students to be admitted is checked by the Selection Committee,

(5) After approval of the students selection list will be submitted to the CH&FW, TS, Hyderabad, before commencement of Training Course.

**FEE STRUCTURE:**

A maximum fee of Rs.1,000/- per month per head shall be charged for Free Seats. As regards to Management Seats, the fee shall not be more than five times the fee applicable for Free Seats. Government will have the authority to fix the maximum fee chargeable for free seats and also to fix an upper limit in respect of fee for the management seats.

**RULES OF RESERVATION:**

Rule of reservation shall be strictly followed while making selection for both free seats and management seats. Unfilled seats meant for reserved categories shall be kept

## **AGE:**

The candidates should have completed the age of 17 years as on 31<sup>st</sup> December of the year in which the admission sought and the upper age limit is 30 years of age. The upper age limit is relaxable by 5 years in case of SC, ST and BC's as per rules in force.

**CATEGORISATION OF SEATS:** 60% of the total number of seats shall be called "Free Seats" and the remaining 40% shall be called "Management Seats"

**METHOD OF ADMISSION:** (1) Admission to "Free seats" shall be made by a selection committee consisting of the following:

The above committee shall make selections purely based on the merit, on the basis of aggregate marks obtained by the candidates in the minimum qualifying examination for Multipurpose Health Workers (Female) Training Course i.e., Intermediate Public Examination or its equivalent with any group. In declaring such merit, candidates who pass under compartmental system shall be placed after candidates who passed in a single attempt and other guidelines for finalizing the merit will be followed.

(2) The Principals of Private MPHWF Training Institutions shall admit candidates as allotted by the above committee on the basis of ranking assigned to them against 60% "Free seats"

(3) The maximum number of students to be admitted in an institution shall not exceed (40) forty. However, if infrastructural facilities, teaching staff etc., in an institution are found to be inadequate to train (40) forty students, Government have the right to permit a lesser number of students.

(4) Admission to "Management Seats" shall be done by the institution only after the list of students to be admitted is checked by the Selection Committee,

(5) After approval of the students selection list will be submitted to the CH&FW, TS, Hyderabad, before commencement of Training Course.

## **FEE STRUCTURE:**

A maximum fee of Rs.1,000/- per month per head shall be charged for Free Seats. As regards to Management Seats, the fee shall not be more than five times the fee applicable for Free Seats. Government will have the authority to fix the maximum fee chargeable for free seats and also to fix an upper limit in respect of fee for the management seats.

## **RULES OF RESERVATION:**

Rule of reservation shall be strictly followed while making selection for both free seats and management seats. Unfilled seats meant for reserved categories shall be kept

For the Management Seats also, the candidates are required to fill up the online application, download the filled-in application and submit the same along with the Management quota lists to the selection committee for its approval.

The candidates also be informed that the recognition status of the MPHWF Training Institutions with regard to Indian Nursing Council/ Telangana Nursing and Midwifery Council can be verified in the respective websites 1) [www.indiannursingcouncil.org](http://www.indiannursingcouncil.org) and The department will not be held responsible for the admission of the candidates in a non-recognized institutions.

The Department will not be held responsible for any postal delays for non-receipt of applications on or before the stipulated date i.e.18/12/2021 by 5.00 PM

Entire process of selection has to be completed by 31/12/2021. As soon as the selection procedure is completed as per the above instructions and guidelines, the selection lists should be submitted to this office duly approved by the Selection Committee members on or before 07/01/2022 without fail. The selection list should indicate very clearly the number of candidates under free and management quota for each private nursing schools separately.

Hence, the District Medical and Health Officers concerned are requested to follow the above instructions strictly while making admissions for MPHWF / ANM Training Course in to 1<sup>st</sup> year for the Academic year 2021-2022 as per liability.

The District Medical and Health Officers are noted in the margin entry is also requested to issue suitable orders/instructions to concerned Principals of all Government MPHWF Training Institutes in the state, to follow the principles of hygiene, social distancing must be advocated by all at all times to ensure the health, safety and security of the students, faculty and staff in view of COVID-19.
