Sub: COVID-19-Hospital based surveillance for Severe Acute Respiratory Infections (SARI) as a surrogate marker for community-based spread of COVID-19 - Reg.

In view of Novel Corona Viral Disease (COVID-19)being declared as Pandemic by the World Health Organisation, there is a need to identifyadmissions due to Severe Acute Respiratory Infections (SARI)/Pneumonia in the hospitals. This will be used as surrogate marker for COVID-19. A rising trend of SARI/Pneumonia cases will trigger the

need for further investigation for COVID-19.

SARI/Pneumonia surveillance will be done in hospitals where majority of the patients get admitted for severe respiratory problems, identical to those seen in COVID-19. All Teaching Hospitals, District Hospital, Area Hospitals and Corporate& Other privateHospitals are being identified as sentinel sites for surveillance. These hospitals shallreport daily on the following format:

To facilitate reporting, the criteria for reporting SARI cases are as given below:

- Age above 15 years
- 2. H/o fever or currently having fever
- 3. Any respiratory symptoms severe cough / shortness of breath
- 4. Hospitalisation

If the patient has all the above four conditions, it should be immediately reported to the state IDSP team on Whatsapp at the following number (Dr.Seema Tabassum: 9059746612) and mail

to <u>idsp@telangana.gov.in</u> The line list of patients should be maintained by all the hospitals and should be shared as and when asked.

The reporting shall start retrospectively from 8<sup>th</sup> of March 2020 to understand the baseline admissions of the facility.
