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The District Medical and Health Officers noted in the address entry are informed that the MPH W(F) Training Course Regular Examinations of 2nd year of 2019-2021 regular batch and 1st year of 2020-2022 regular batch and the students who are failed in the previous MPH W(F) Examination in 1st and 2nd year scheduled to be conducted from **26.07.2022 to 01.08.2022**. The examination centers which were proposed in the earlier examinations may be confirmed for Theory, Practicals and Oral examinations. They should have adequate facilities such as water supply, electricity, sitting arrangements etc.

You are requested to nominate the name of the Chief Superintendent of Examinations from among the Officer's cadre of the Principal R.T.C (F) / Project Officer (DTT)/ Medical Officer MPH W(Male) Training School/ Dist Immunization Officer / Dy DM&HO/ Additional DM&HO who will be responsible for conducting the examinations, collection of examination material and for submission of answer scripts along with the Practical's and Orals marks in sealed bundles to this office immediately on completion of the examinations.

The information regarding the examination centre, name of the Chief Examiner and having facilities etc. should be furnished to the email i.e, mphwfrhs@gmail.com so as to reach this office on or before 18.07.2022 in the name cover of **Dr. Amar Singh Naik**, Joint Director(PS&SP), office of the Commissioner of Health & Family Welfare, Sultan Bazar, Koti, Hyderabad.

The above Examinations will be conducted for regular candidates who have completed 2nd year 2020-021 (2019-2021) regular batch and 1st year of 2020-2021 (2020-2022) regular batch (2 years course), as per the circular issued by the Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi and State Government.

Examination Fee structure is as follows:

- 1) For 1st and 2nd year – Rs.500/- for all subjects.

The above fee should be remitted by way of Demand Draft drawn in favor of **“The Commissioner of Health & Family Welfare, Telangana, Hyderabad”** in any nationalized bank on or **before 05.07.2022**. Fees once paid will not be refunded or adjusted under any circumstances. No Extra amount will be accepted, other than the list of candidates submitted.

IMPORTANT POINTS TO FOLLOW:

- The MPHWS (F) Training Course Examination applications of the candidates along with INTERNAL ASSESSMENT MARKS should be uploaded in the CH&FW official Web site (<http://chfw.telangana.gov.in>) and the same will be available from 21.06.2022 to 05.07.2022.
- No institution shall submit average internal marks of the total students more than 75% i.e., if 40 students are admitted in a course the average score of the 40 students shall not exceed 75% of total internal marks as per the INC regulations. Hence, keeping in view of the above provision, submit the internal marks through online.

- Then, takeout the Printout of the application forms, enclose the examination fee of the students of training institute (Original Demand Draft) along with required documents to the application i.e., Original Selection List approved by the District Selection committee, copy of SSC Certificate, Hospital and Rural training certificate in respect of Regular candidates, should be submitted to this office on or before 05.07.2022 by 5.00 P.M

Further, the Principals of MPH W (F) Training Institutes should also follow the following instructions scrupulously.

- 1) All the applications should have the enclosures as noted in the application form. Incomplete and incorrect applications will be summarily rejected.
- 2) As per the examination schedule, the candidates should produce their practical Record at the examination center concerned.
- 3) The Principals of MPH W (F) Training Institutes are informed that proper care should be taken while filling up the Application form **Online**.
- 4) All the Principals of MPH W (F) Training Institutes are instructed to submit the Attendance Certificate for both theory and Practical's of the students of their concerned institutes along with hard copy of the examination applications without fail. They are also informed that unless the internal Assessment marks are uploaded, the applications will not be accepted for uploaded through online. They are also informed that if any student fails in Internal Assessment Marks of any subject such student is not allowed to write the examination for that subject only. In such a case caution to be taken while filling up of the application for appearing other subjects.
- 5) Practical examination is conducted as per guidelines of Indian Nursing Council. Practical exam must be conducted at District Hospital having skill lab by Nursing faculty having experience in MPH W(F) Training Programme.
- 6) Maximum number of attempts permitted for each paper is 3 including first attempt.
- 7) Maximum duration of completion of the course is 4 years.
- 8) A candidate failing in more than one subject shall not permitted to the next year.
- 9) No candidate shall be permitted to appear in the second year examination unless the candidate passes the first year examination.

Further, they are informed that the Hall tickets for the eligible candidates to appear for the examinations will be issued as per the Indian Nursing Council Regulations, New Delhi.
